United States Attorney Karin Immergut and Oregon Attorney General Hardy Myers will convene a media event on Thursday, October 6, 2005 at 10:00 a.m. on the second floor of the federal courthouse in Portland. Ms. Immergut and Attorney General Myers will announce the Oregon Safe Cyberspace Initiative, an alliance of technology and Internet access providers, law enforcement, and state and federal governments. The announcement coincides with October being proclaimed National Cyber Security Awareness Month. The event will begin with a computer hacking demonstration by Andrew Plato, President of Anitian Enterprise Security. Mr. Plato will demonstrate how easily data can be stolen from a computer without adequate security. The event will also introduce a Public Service Announcement and a brochure developed by the Federal Trade Commission and the National Cyber Security Alliance concerning the critical need for computer security. Representatives of a number of Initiative partners will be available for interviews at the conclusion of the event.
